Patriot Day

This Monday is Patriot Day. In the United States, Patriot Day, observed as the National Day of Service and Remembrance, occurs on September 11 of each year in memory of the people killed in the 2001 September 11 attacks.

In the immediate **aftermath** of the attacks, President George W. Bush, proclaimed Friday September 14, 2001, as a National Day of Prayer and Remembrance for the Victims of the Terrorist Attacks on September 11, 2001.

The flag of the United States is flown at half-staff at the White House and on all U.S. government buildings and establishments throughout the world; flags are also encouraged to be displayed on individual American homes. Additionally, a moment of silence is observed to correspond with the attacks, beginning at 8:46 a.m. (Eastern Daylight Time), the time the first plane, American Airlines Flight 11, struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001.




Kingsbury City Limits

National Night Out


The National Night Out event in Kingsbury is coming up on Tuesday, October 3rd from 5:30 pm - 7 pm in downtown Kingsbury at the tree.

Everyone in the Kingsbury area is welcome to attend. Come on down and meet your friends and neighbors!




Burn Ban Is On

The Guadalupe County Commissions Court has instituted an outdoor burn ban for Guadalupe County.

The burn ban imposed by the Commissioners Court has specific guidelines for



Welding, cutting, and grinding or any activity that causes a spark

The City of Kingsbury has a "trigger" ordinance where a burn ban is in effect in the city limits whenever there is a burn ban issued by the county.






Of the 254 counties in Texas, there are currently **215** that have a burn ban, up from 213 last week. This leaves only 41 counties still without a burn ban in the state.

Model T Raffle


The Pioneer Flight Museum here in Kingsbury is raffling off a real model T!

there are always aircraft and Model T's that need TLC. Please consider joining and helping out!




Hieronymus and Maria Donsback

A great picture of Hieronymus and Maria Donsbach from Kingsbury sometime in the 1910s or 1920s. Maria was born Maria Schmidt in Germany in 1846 and came to the U.S. and Kingsbury at a young age. Hieronymus was born

in 1844, also in Germany, the son Johann Jost Donsbach and Anna Maria Hermann who passed away in Germany before Hieronymus also came to Kingsbury as a child. Can you imagine what an ocean crossing would have been like for them as children in the mid-nineteenth century?



Both are buried in the Kingsbury Cemetery with a headstone in German saying "Hier Ruht Vater und Mutter" (Here lies Father and Mother) and they passed a year apart, both in the month of "Marz".
